Cho: "Hey, I was in the middle of something."


Jane: "Oh. Sorry. Bear with me."

Cho: "No." Looks up at Jane, pissed.








Frick just looks between the two.

Cho watches Jane leave out of the corner of his eye.








Cut to Jane walking into the squad room, with Cho coming out of the interview room.




Cho just stands there with his arms crossed, not convinced. Turns to leave. He gets to the doorway and Jane stops him.










Jane: Sighs. "Do you have anything with a little more... Zing?"

Cho: "No."















Jane: Watches him go. Calls out, "I'll wait for you. Right here."








Cho turns to look at Jane, then goes back to the interview.



Jane's smile broadens as he watches Cho walk away.










Next scene we see Cho striding into the Calistoga Canyon's bar, wearing all black, sunglasses, looking really hot.
